We want to tell all our clients about a new program we have instituted at SBA called the Personal Treatment Plan (PTP). Because the field of cosmetic dermatology is burgeoning with new lasers, fillers, peels and products coming out every day, it can be a bit confusing and overwhelming for the lay person. Even we dermatologists have to be constantly reading our journals and going to meetings to keep up with all the innovations. The other factor is that everyone's skin-care needs and priorities are different. A 40-year old blonde with rosacea (subtle redness on the cheeks, chin, nose or forehead) will have different recommendations for treatment than a 60-year old with deep lines and sagging jowls. And if you have limited resources to spend on skin rejuvenation, you want to use those dollars wisely so you get more "bang for your buck."

That's exactly why we created the PTP. When you come in to meet with our dermatologists or our physician assistant, we will have a candid discussion with you about your skin concerns. We will literally hand you a mirror and ask you to point out what bothers you and rank the problems in order of priority. We can then tailor a written treatment plan that addresses your concerns and does it in the most cost-effective way. At the end of your consultation, we will give you a copy of your PTP to reference at home, and we will keep a copy in your file.

We will also address timing of the procedures, such as having BOTOX® prior to a Fraxel laser resurfacing or Thermage skin-tightening procedure. We do this because relaxing the muscles of facial expression first will make the skin-tightening and collagen-remodeling deliver a better result if the skin isn't being constantly creased by muscle contractions in the weeks after the procedure. We like to do fillers, such as JUVÉDERM or Radiesse®, after the Fraxel or Thermage procedure

because you may require less filler if the lines and skin laxity have been reduced by one of these procedures.

The other key component of the PTP is recommending and designing a good skin-care regimen. If you use cosmeceuticals at home and apply your sunscreen on a daily basis, you will enhance and preserve the results of whatever laser, BOTOX® Cosmetic or filler treatment you have in our office.

The name of the game is rebuilding the collagen in the skin. That collagen deteriorates as we age. The great thing about skin is that it has an innate ability to regenerate and repair itself. Your skin can show dramatic results if we help nudge it along with retinoids, growth factors, antioxidants and peptides. We carry the top cosmeceutical lines in the business such as Obagi®, SkinMedica®, REVALÉSKIN™, Prevage® and Remergent™. When we create a skin-care regimen for you, we can select the right products from those lines as well as incorporate prescription drugs such as Retin-A, Renova®, Tazorac® and Tri-Luma® to create an effective program designed to meet your goals.

As part of our PTP, when you come in for a consultation, we will take baseline digital photographs to provide a visual starting point. Then, when you complete whatever home and office treatments we recommend, we will take "after" pictures to show you how far you have come. It will really motivate you to stick with a good skin-care regimen when you see the difference. We have a wonderful medical photographer, Laine Maier, who does our excellent photography.

ANTIOXIDANTS

More and more research is validating the benefits of using topical antioxidants as part of a good skin-care regimen. Daily exposure to environmental elements, such as sun, wind, cigarette smoke and chemicals, produces damaging reactive oxygen species (ROS), such as free radicals, oxygen ions, and peroxide in our skin leading to multiple pathways of oxidative stress. A broad spectrum antioxidant can effectively neutralize the ROS in multiple steps of the oxidative pathway. This helps to protect against damage and DNA mutations, which can prevent healthy cell regeneration and lead to signs of photo-damage, including fine lines, wrinkles, loss of elasticity, discoloration and even skin cancer. In addition to helping prevent damage from sun and other environmental exposures, clinical studies have shown that antioxidants can reduce fine lines, wrinkles, laxity, mottled texture and age spots for dramatically healthier, stronger and visibly radiant skin beginning as early as four weeks.

Of the new crop of antioxidants that have come on the market recently, we have chosen to offer three for sale in our clinic – Phloretin CF™ by SkinCeuticals®, TNS Essential Serum™ by SkinMedica®, and REVALÉSKIN™ by Stiefel. Phloretin CF is a broad-spectrum treatment that protects against free radicals and a range of other reactive molecules known to cause damage to skin cells. It also can correct existing skin damage. Phloretin CF comes in the form of a serum, which is applied by rubbing in four to five drops with the fingertips to clean skin on the face, neck and chest before you apply your sunscreen.

The TNS Essential Serum contains the same growth factors that are in TNS Recovery Complex® along with a potent cocktail of antioxidants,

peptides and other innovative anti-aging ingredients. It provides a won-derfully-smooth, hydrated feeling to the skin. If you use the TNS Essential Serum, there is no need to use TNS Recovery Complex because it does everything the Recovery Complex does plus more due to the additional antioxidants. The TNS Essential Serum is used twice a day. In the morning, it should go on first before your sunscreen. Before bedtime, it should be applied after your topical retinoid (Retinol, Retin-A or Tazorac®).

REVALÉSKIN™ contains a potent antioxidant called CoffeeBerry®. It comes as a day cream with SPF 1.5 and a hydrating night cream. You can use the REVALÉSKIN Day Cream every morning on top of the Phloretin CF or the TNS Essential Serum if you want to really rev up your antioxidant protection. The REVALÉSKIN Night Cream is also great to use on top of your retinoid at night because you are getting a great antioxidant along with hydration to counter the potentially-drying effects of the retinoid. Or, if you have such sensitive skin that cannot tolerate retinoids, the REVALÉSKIN Night Cream will still provide anti-wrinkle benefits used as a stand-alone treatment. REVALÉSKIN also comes as a cleanser, which has a pleasant grapefruit fragrance and also contains the CoffeeBerry anti-oxidant. REVALÉSKIN Day Cream, Night Cream and Cleanser come packaged together at a discounted price, or they can be purchased separately.

RESTORING A YOUTHFUL FACE

Have you ever looked at pictures of yourself from years past and With mid-face enhancement, we are treating the problem, not the sympthought, "Why can't I have that fresh, young look again?" We can help you achieve that! With our newest dermal filler, Radiesse®, we are augmenting cheeks and restoring

facial volume for a more youthful look.

The new direction in facial fillers is enhancing mid-face volume, or the apples of the cheeks. As we age, gravity causes the normal fat pockets under the skin to migrate downward. This gives a drawn, sometimes tired look to our faces. Our cheekbones appear flattened.

Radiesse, a long-lasting, FDA-approved dermal filler, is safe and does a wonderful job restoring facial volume. We place Radiesse deep in the skin to restore the natural cheek contours. In doing so, nasolabial folds (the lines between our nose and mouth) and marionette lines (the downward lines at the corner of our mouth) are lifted so there may be little or no need to fill these areas. tom. And the best news is that the results are immediate and long-lasting! Radiesse will last up to 18 months so there is no need for frequent touch-ups.

> Radiesse is composed of calcium-based microscopic spheres suspended in a water-based gel. It is biocompatible so there is no need for prior skin testing. After about three months, the water-based gel dissolves naturally and the calcium-based spheres stimulate the body to build new collagen. Over time, the calcium spheres absorb naturally. As with any filler, common side effects are redness, bruising, and swelling in the treated area. These side effects are temporary and most resolve within a few days.

FRACTIONAL RESURFACING

We are pleased to introduce the latest in fractional skin resurfacing the Fraxel re:pair™ laser system (Re:pair). This system delivers a new type of treatment called Fractional Deep Dermal Ablation, designed to improve deep lines and wrinkles, textural irregularities (acne scars), pigmented lesions (age and sun spots, freckles, melasma and other skin discoloration), and vascular changes (redness) on the face and neck. The FDA-cleared Re:pair was introduced at the 66th Annual Meeting of the American Academy of Dermatology in San Antonio in February 2008. It has already become the new paradigm in CO2 skin resurfacing. The New York Post named it as a "Best Quality-of-Life Breakthrough" for wrinkles. The Today show called it a "mini-medical miracle" that could help patients avoid face lifts.

Fraxel is a laser technology that gets its name by resurfacing only a fraction of the skin with each treatment. With the Fraxel, a cluster of tiny laser beams is delivered to the skin, forming microscopic treatment zones. With the Re:pair, those treatment zones are tiny columns of vaporized or ablated skin - hence the treatment is called Fractional Deep Dermal Ablation (FDDA™). The treated area contracts and tightens the surrounding skin while also breaking up unwanted pigment. Because the surrounding skin is unaffected, the Re:pair FDDA treatment dramatically reduces the recovery time and risk factors usually associated with a traditional CO₂ resurfacing.

So, what does this new Fraxel treatment mean in terms of results? Reddish, brown-spotted, wrinkled, sun-damaged skin becomes smoother, tighter, less red and more even in appearance. We have seen sensational results with our patients - on their faces, around their eyes and on their necks - all the areas that get the most sun damage from chronic ultraviolet exposure. You will find before-and-after pictures of some of our Re:pair patients on our website. We are also using it successfully on facial acne scars.

The Re:pair joins with our Fraxel re:store[™] laser system (Re:store) to offer our patients a choice in fractional laser treatments. The Re:pair can

deliver more results in fewer treatments than the Re:store. Roughly, one Re:pair treatment is equal to four or five Re:store treatments. Patients wanting to achieve results faster may prefer the Re:pair. However, the downtime with the Re:pair is greater due in part to the ablative nature of the treatment. Also, the amount of downtime correlates with how aggressively we set the laser parameters. Generally speaking, deeper wrinkles and greater skin laxity call for stronger energy settings on the laser and, hence, greater downtime. Patients with less severe wrinkles and laxity will experience less downtime.

During the first 48 to 72 hours after the Re:pair treatment, there will be redness, swelling, pinpoint bleeding, oozing and crusting. Usually by day four or five, the skin is still pink or red and still somewhat swollen, but makeup can be worn to cover the redness. The newlyhealed skin retains some degree of pinkness, which gradually fades over a few weeks up to a month. To help with healing, reduce downtime and enhance results, patients receive a series of Omnilux™ LED skin rejuvenation light-therapy treatments. During these office visits, we closely monitor our patients' post-laser course of healing.

Of course, sunscreen is essential to protect your beautiful new skin. In addition, we recommend using anti-aging skin-care products, containing active ingredients such as antioxidants, growth factors and retinoids to continue the collagen-building process. Like the Re:store treatment, the Re:pair procedure triggers collagen remodeling. That remodeling continues for six months or more after the procedure.

Just like any procedure, there are possible risks associated with the Re:pair laser treatment, including infection, pigmentation changes and scarring. By proper patient selection and judicious use of the laser, these risks can be minimized.

AT THE CENTER FOR SKIN RESEARCH

The Center for Skin Research is our dermatological research division. We conduct clinical research trials for major pharmaceutical companies and clinical research organizations seeking U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approval. The research involves testing investigational drugs and treatment devices for a wide variety of skin problems, such as acne, actinic keratoses (sun spots), eczema, hyperhidrosis (excessive sweating), psoriasis and skin aging.
